WINEMAKER'S NOTES

A fully ripe and aromatically complex wine with beautiful acidity and freshness. The fruit carries earthiness and structure. There are aromas of crushed bramble berries, forest floor, and ocean spray, with a long yet light palate.

VINIFICATION PROCESS

The Marimar Vineyard is located on the true Sonoma Coast, west of Freestone, on a hillside surrounded by Redwoods and Douglas Fir trees cooled by morning fog and afternoon sea breezes. The 2019 growing season brought ample spring rains and mild weather through harvest.

STORY

Japanese for "The Sound of Water", Mizu No Oto Pinot Noir is inspired by our love for wines from the Sonoma Coast. The koi fish has long been a symbol of perseverance through adversity in Japan, fitting for a notoriously difficult grape to grow.
